Terry's 3 TDs lift Vikings

Receiver's trio of scoring catches in 4th is difference

EAST LANSING — Lucas Barner's three touchdown passes to Leondre Terry in the fourth quarter lifted Everett to a come-from-behind CAAC Blue victory on Friday.

Terry scored on catches of 26, 74 and 28 yards after the second weather delay of the night as the Vikings pulled away to a 25-17 victory.

"We knew it was going to be a tough game on the road in East Lansing, but we just stayed focused throughout the game," said Everett coach Marcelle Carruther said.

East Lansing started the game with a long drive, culminating in a field goal. The Vikings responded with an early touchdown, but just before the end of the second quarter, East Lansing scored a touchdown and entered the locker room with a 10-6 advantage.

Weather delayed the game just before the second half started and again with 11:50 left in the fourth quarter.

Immediately when play resumed, Barner hit Terry for a first down, then found him again on third down for a 26-yard touchdown and took the lead, 12-10.

"The weather delay actually gave us a chance to go over some things and make some adjustments," Carruthers said.

"We had those rain delays and when we got back on the field, they just caught us a little flat and we had trouble coming back," East Lansing assistant coach Gianni Fera-

co said.

On Everett's second offensive drive of the quarter, Barner connected with Terry again on a 74-yarder to push the lead to 19-10.

East Lansing was able to find some offensive momentum with 4:30 left when running back Tony Knox ran for an 18-yard touchdown, closing the gap to 19-17.

Terry answered, though, with his third touchdown catch with 2:52 left on the clock to put the game away.

"I just know how to make big plays and how to come through for my team," Terry said.

"That's what I did." Terry finished the night with five catches and 146 yards, while Barner threw for 298 yards.

"Lucas really stepped up his game this week after not playing last week," Carruthers said.

"But I have to acknowledge our defense. East Lansing has a very strong offensive line, but our guys just worked very hard and stayed on them."
